This matter coming on to be heard on the plaintiff's unopposed motion for preliminary approval of their settlement agreement, the parties being present through counsel and the Court having been fully and duly advised of the premises,


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Court preliminarily approves of the Settlement Agreement presented by the parties and the terms of the settlement as outlined therein, including the remuneration to class representative Mary Williams attorney fees to Berton Ring P.C., payments to class members, type of and form of notice, the method of service and claims process.
2. The Court preliminarily finds the terms, notice, form of notice, and the method of service of the notice to be fair and reasonable and appoints The Notice Company, Inc. of Hingham, MA as the Class Administrator to implement the notice and claims process as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.
3. The Notice Period shall begin as of the date of entry of this Order Preliminarily Approving Settlement, with a deadline 80 days thereafter for submission of all claims, requests for exclusion and objections to the Settlement, subject to such extension of time by the Class Administrator as authorized in the Settlement Agreement.
4. This cause is continued to July 20, 2026 at 11:00 A.M., either in courtroom 2402 Daley Center, 50 W Washington, Chicago, Illinois or via Zoom (*Meeting ID: 955-0046-1687, Session Passcode: 640378*) or by calling in 312 626-6799, for a fairness hearing and hearing on class exclusions and/or objections, if any, on the settlement.

5. Count III is dismissed per the parties settlement agreement.
